

Emergency Meeting
October 8, 2018

Chairman Dexter Barber called the Emergency Meeting to order. Present at the meeting were Commissioners Dexter Barber, Scott Phillips, James Sanders, Dewayne Branch, Jim Johnson, Attorney Robin Myers, Clerk Kathleen Brown and Deputy Clerk Mason Kever.

Commissioner Branch led Prayer.

Commissioner Sanders led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion to adopt the agenda made by Commissioner Johnson, second by Commissioner Sanders, and carried.

Motion to approve Resolution 2018-37, declaring a Local State of Emergency due to Hurricane Michael pursuant to Executive Order Number 18-276 made by Commissioner Johnson, second by Commissioner Sanders, and carried. Emergency Management gave the Board a report on the storm. The Liberty County Schools will be closed Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday as of now.

The Board discussed County employee compensation due to Hurricane Michael closures. Motion to pay all essential employees time and a half for all hours worked during the storm made by Commissioner Johnson, second by Commissioner Sanders, and carried.

Motion by Branch, second by Johnson and carried to close County offices in unison with the Second Circuit Courts from noon October 9, 2018 to Friday, October 12, 2018.

Motion to accept offer made by Tracy Johnson to purchase remaining building as is located at the Sheriff's Office for \$1450.00 made Commissioner Sanders, second by Commissioner Branch, and carried.

Motion to close restrooms at Bentley Bluff Boat Landing due to vandalism made by Commissioner Sanders, second by Commissioner Branch, and carried.

The Board cancelled Executive Session previously scheduled for October 9, 2018 due to Hurricane Michael. They will re-schedule for a later date.

Motion to adjourn by Commissioner Sander, second by Commissioner Phillips and carried.
